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CURRICULUM & PEDAGOGY

In keeping with NEP 2020, Aparna Public School facilitates experiential learning through a multilayered curriculum approach based on the multiple-intelligences theory. Learning programmes are thoughtfully planned in an enjoyable manner — indoor and outdoor games, storytelling sessions, panel theatre, puppet shows, project work, origami, field trips and school cinema — with a strong focus on the development of listening, speaking, reading, writing and arithmetic skills.



EARTH DAY — LEARNING BY DOING

Students have countless opportunities to assimilate knowledge, discover hidden talents, follow their dreams and grow into global citizens. Through a well-balanced curriculum, a range of skills and values are built to ensure the holistic growth of each child. Learning takes place through interactive, play-way methods; children are encouraged to be kind to their peers and respectful to all. Our teachers treat children as individuals — caring and affectionate, yet firm and fair.

The curriculum embraces all three dimensions of education — academics, co-curricular activities and sports. These activities not only tap the innate and latent talents of a child but also enhance attention span and core scholastic skills, building the confidence needed to excel in today's world.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

We use innovative methods of learning that minimise the use of paper through semi-virtual classrooms. In kindergarten, teaching takes place through play-way and Montessori methods alongside a variety of teaching practices, supported by field trips, phonetics, drawing, origami and craft, music and dance, public speaking, puppetry and panel-theatre shows. In senior classes, students engage in model UN conferences, mock WHO and UNICEF sessions, seminars and presentations that build research, communication and leadership skills.

Any special-skill activity is offered subject to a minimum group size of 8 to 10 students.

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BEYOND ACADEMICS

MORNING ASSEMBLY

The assembly is conducted every morning, with commands given by a student of the class on duty. A typical assembly includes the morning prayer, a thought for the day, current news and a short speech by students, birthday celebrations, simple yoga and activation exercises, and the National Anthem. Kindergarten children hold a simultaneous assembly featuring show-and-tell, rhymes, storytelling, puppetry and music, with yoga and meditation forming an integral part of both.

VALUE INCULCATION

Environmental Education, Value Education and Music are woven into the weekly schedule, supported by carefully selected audio-visual resources projected on large screens for every class. The aim is to provide value-based education through classics and renowned literature. Yoga, Art & Craft, Music & Dance and Games & Sports are taken up regularly for all, while House programmes throughout the year include competitions, cultural presentations, seminars and exhibitions. Life skills are integrated within Social Studies and EVS lessons.

SPORTS & THE HOUSE SYSTEM

Physical education and sport hold an honoured place at Aparna. Students participate in a wide range of indoor and outdoor games, while the House system fosters healthy competition, teamwork and leadership through inter-house events spanning academics, culture and athletics across the academic year.

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EXAMINATION & ASSESSMENT

Assessment at Aparna Public School follows the framework laid down by the CBSE, New Delhi, blending continuous internal assessment with periodic written examinations. The pattern emphasises understanding and application over rote memorisation, and tracks each child's progress across the full academic year.

The final result combines marks from periodic tests, notebook submission, subject enrichment activities and the half-yearly and annual examinations, in line with CBSE norms. Classes X and XII additionally prepare for the CBSE Board examinations through pre-board assessments.

CONTINUOUS INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

- Projects: One project per term per subject from Class I onwards, in keeping with CBSE bye-laws.
- Assignments: Children from Class I onwards complete assignments that summarise each chapter or unit, to be done by the children themselves and credited at the time of evaluation.
- Worksheets: Activity sheets on general topics, used during substitution classes and as homework across classes.
- Homework: Set per the homework schedule; Nursery to Class II receive enjoyable fun sheets and activity sheets in place of formal homework.
- Internal Assessment Notebook: Class work, projects, practicals and assignments are recorded in a dedicated notebook and evaluated for terminal and final results.

SCIENCE LABORATORY

From Class III onwards, practical learning is structured progressively — demonstration classes for Class III, a mix of demonstrations and practicals for Classes IV and V, and twelve experiments for Class VI and above — nurturing genuine scientific temper and hands-on skill.

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ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ONLINE REGISTRATION

- Registration forms are available on the School website at www.aparnapublicschool.in/online_admission.
- The registration process comprises four stages, capturing details of the student, parents and previous schooling.
- On completing the form, a registration fee of Rs. 500 is to be deposited.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Duly filled and signed registration form.
- Passport-size photographs of the candidate (pasted in the form).
- Postcard-size photograph of the candidate with parents (attached to the form).
- Photocopy of the Birth Certificate issued by a municipal authority.
- Photocopy of the Aadhaar Card and previous class report card.
- Original Transfer Certificate (to be submitted before the academic session begins).

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

- Incomplete or illegible forms without photographs will be considered invalid.
- Registration is followed by an interaction session; admission is not guaranteed by registration and depends on the admission test, interaction and seat availability.
- Admission for Pre-Nursery to Class II is based on interaction and observation; Class III onwards involves an interaction followed by a written test.
- The date of birth in the registration form must match the Birth Certificate.

HOW TO PAY

- Online: Fees can be paid securely through the Parents' Corner after logging in at www.aparnapublicschool.in. The portal supports leading payment methods and issues an instant receipt.
- At the School Office: Payments may also be made at the fee counter during the published collection hours on working days.

FEE GUIDELINES

- Fees are payable by the notified due date; the applicable late fine is added automatically thereafter and is reflected in the Parents' Corner and on the fee receipt.
- One month's written notice, or a month's fee in lieu of notice, is required before the withdrawal of a student.
- Students leaving in May are required to pay the fees for June.
- Transfer Certificates, other certificates and board examination forms are issued only after all dues have been cleared.

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SCHOOL UNIFORM & DRESS CODE

The School uniform is a mark of identity, equality and discipline. Every student is expected to attend School in the prescribed uniform, neat and well-maintained, on all working days. The uniform reflects the dignity of the institution, and students are expected to wear it with pride.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- The complete prescribed uniform is to be worn on all regular school days.
- The designated sports / house uniform is to be worn on days notified for physical education and games.
- Black school shoes with the prescribed socks; shoes must be clean and properly laced.
- Hair must be neatly groomed; long hair is to be tied with the prescribed accessories. Nails should be trimmed and clean.
- Jewellery and expensive personal articles are discouraged; the School is not responsible for their loss.
- The School identity card is part of the uniform and must be carried every day.

WHERE TO OBTAIN THE UNIFORM

Approved uniform and book vendor details are shared with all parents well in time through group SMS and the Parents' Corner on the School website. Parents are advised to procure the complete set before the session begins so that children are appropriately turned out from the first day.

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SCHOOL TIMINGS

Punctuality is a habit the School values deeply. Students are expected to reach School before the assembly bell so that the day begins calmly and on time. The School office operates during working hours on all school days. Parents wishing to meet the Principal or teachers are requested to take a prior appointment through the office or the Parents' Corner, so that meetings can be attended to without disrupting class time. Visitors are welcome on campus during school hours through the reception.

RULES, REGULATIONS & CODE OF CONDUCT

The following rules exist to nurture a safe, respectful and orderly learning community. Admission to the School implies acceptance of these rules by both students and parents.

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

- Regular attendance and punctuality are essential; a minimum attendance is required to be eligible for promotion and examinations.
- Leave of absence must be sought in advance in writing; absence due to illness should be supported by a medical certificate where applicable.
- Students must be present for all examinations; those who miss an examination without valid reason may forfeit marks for that assessment.

CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

- Students are expected to be courteous and respectful to staff and peers, both inside and outside the School.
- Care must be taken of School property; wilful damage will be made good by the parents.
- Use of mobile phones and other prohibited gadgets in School is not permitted.
- The School emphasises respectful behaviour; impolite conduct towards staff, inside or outside the School, may lead to strict disciplinary action.

PROMOTION POLICY

- Promotion from Prep to Class IX and to Class XI is based on the student's overall performance across the entire academic year.
- Class teachers maintain an updated record of each student's progress through quarterly reports.
- Year-end results are final; answer sheets will not be reconsidered or shown to students.

WITHDRAWAL & TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

WITHDRAWAL

- One month's written notice, or a month's fee in lieu, is required before withdrawal; exceptions apply to sudden transfers of Government or Military personnel.
- Transfer Certificates are issued only after all dues are cleared.
- A student may be asked to leave on grounds of serious disciplinary issues, persistently unsatisfactory academic progress, or detention in a class.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE (TC) RULES

- A written application for the Transfer Certificate must be submitted by the parent/guardian in the prescribed form at the School office.
- The TC is issued only after clearance of all dues — school fees, fines and library books; caution money, if any, is adjusted as per School rules.
- A TC charge of Rs. 300/- is payable at the time of application and is non-refundable.
- The TC is ordinarily issued within seven (7) working days of application, subject to clearance of all dues.
- In the case of withdrawal during the session, fees remain payable up to and including the month of withdrawal, in addition to the one month's notice requirement stated above.
- A duplicate TC is issued only against a written declaration/affidavit from the parent/guardian, on payment of the applicable charge.
- All entries in the TC — date of birth, class and conduct — are made strictly as per the School records and in accordance with CBSE norms; no alteration or addition is permissible under any circumstances.
